## Music Ministry

“Thank you!” to all those in Music Ministry who helped to make our Holy Week and 8am and 10am Easter services at Holy Trinity so beautiful. Members of the Parish Choir, Partington Bell Choir and instrumentalists devote many hours of rehearsal creating meaningful, worship-filled music at Holy Trinity. Thank you, Julian Davies, for enhancing the hymns and anthems on Palm Sunday, Easter, and throughout the year with your recorder and trumpet; Shellie Keit, for your beautiful flute and Missy Rovinelli for your recorder music as well. We are truly blessed to have such dedicated singers, ringers and instrumentalists in our parish. On Easter Day we had thirty-four singers and eleven ringers ranging in age from fourteen to almost ninety! The Easter services were absolutely breathtaking. We had many favorable comments from parishioners and visitors.

Our twenty minutes of pre-service music on both Palm Sunday and Easter were very well received. The Partington Bell Choir presented numerous songs from our “Ring and Rejoice” series. The Easter and Palm Sunday anthems were medleys from two choral collections by Dr. Benjamin Harlan entitled, “Resurrection Alleluias” and “Easter Trilogy”, as well as a hauntingly beautiful anthem, “Hosanna”, by Hazel Hedges, which musically reflects the gloom, doom, anticipation, chaos and turmoil of The Sunday of the Passion. Thank you, Dr. Harlan for your glorious music, so beautifully sung by our fabulous choir at Holy Trinity.

It was wonderful having Emily Hammell home from Florida Southern singing with us. Along with our sopranos, the descants were glorious.

Once again this year there was music for the Easter Sunrise Service, with those in attendance singing the beautiful familiar hymns of resurrection.

On April 8<sup>th</sup> (Easter 2) The Children of Holy Trinity sang “Everybody Sing Allelu!”, by Randy Repp; “Christ Arose, Alleluia on an Easter Day!” by Natalie Sleeth; and “The Lord’s Prayer”, from the “Rejoice Mass” by Herbert Draesel. They were accompanied by their back-up singers, AKA the Holy Trinity Choir! The children are terrific! Thank you, parents for making sure that the children are here and ready to go. They truly are a blessing to our worship experience!

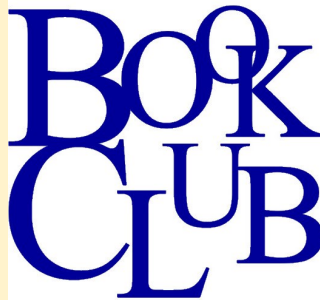
